AGREEMENTS FOR ON-CALL CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT SERVICES

BACKGROUND

- A. The Department of Utilities utilizes on-call construction management consultants to assure construction compliance with specifications and standards during periods of peak workload. These agreements are "on-call" and consultants may be utilized if City staff is not able to provide the necessary inspection services in a timely manner.
- B. In February, 2010, the Department of Utilities issued a Request for Proposals for on-call construction management services. Eleven firms submitted proposals, and Vali Cooper & Associates, Inc., Psomas, and Salabar Associates, Inc. were selected as the three top ranked firms.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The City Manager is authorized to sign a Professional Services Agreement for on-call construction management services with Vali Cooper & Associates, Inc. for an amount not to exceed \$200,000.
- Section 2. The City Manager is authorized to sign a Professional Services Agreement for on-call construction management services with Psomas for an amount not to exceed \$200,000.
- Section 3. The City Manager is authorized to sign a Professional Services Agreement for on-call construction management services with Salabar Associates, Inc. for an amount not to exceed \$200,000.


