RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TEMPORARY STREET CLOSURE OF THE ALLEY THROUGH FOUR (4) ALLEYS WITHIN THE OLD NORTH SACRAMENTO NEIGHBORHOOD LOCATED IN COUNCIL DISTRICT 2 (TEMPORARY STREET CLOSURE PROCEEDING NOS. TSC03-03, TSC03-05, TSC03-06 & TSC03-07)

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

1. In accordance with Section 21101.4 of the Vehicle Code of the State of California and Chapter 12.16 of the Sacramento City Code, on February 24, 2004, City Council conducted a public hearing to consider approval of the temporary closure of the following alleys:
 - a. The alley bounded by Calvados Avenue, Fairfield Street, Arden Way and Forrest Street (TSC03-03).
 - b. The alley bounded by Calvados Avenue, Cantalier Street, Arden Way and Oakmont Street (TSC03-05).
 - c. The Alley bounded by Calvados Avenue, Oakmont Street, Arden Way and Cambridge Street (TSC03-06).
 - d. The Alley bounded by El Camino Avenue, Empress Street, Dixieanne Avenue, Beaumont Street (TSC03-07).
2. Based upon substantial evidence present in the record of the proceedings regarding this matter, City Council hereby makes the following findings:
 - There is serious and continual criminal activity in the area of the alleys recommended for temporary closure. This finding is based upon a recommendation of the police department.
 - The alleys recommended for temporary closure are under the City's jurisdiction and has not been designated as a through highway or arterial street.
 - Vehicular or pedestrian traffic in the alleys recommended for temporary closure contribute to the criminal activities that are occurring there.

- The closures will not substantially adversely affect traffic flow, safety on the adjacent streets or in the surrounding neighborhoods, the operation of emergency vehicles, the performance of municipal or public utility services, or the delivery of freight by commercial vehicles in the area of the alleys proposed to be temporarily closed.
3. City Council finds and determines that the temporary closure of the subject alleys will substantially alleviate the existing serious and continual criminal activity in those alleys.
 4. City Council grants this temporary closure of the alleys with the following conditions:
 - a. A gate security device approved by the Sacramento Fire Department will be installed on the gates.
 - b. City departments and utility companies will have twenty-four (24) hour access to their facilities within the alleys.
 - c. In the event that the gate security device requires construction by a private entity for improvements in the public right-of-way, a revocable encroachment permit and an excavation permit must be obtained from the Public Works Department. The revocable encroachment permit is to be issued simultaneously with this resolution. The excavation permit, if required, may be issued subsequent to this resolution, but must be obtained prior to the construction of improvements in the public right-of-way.
