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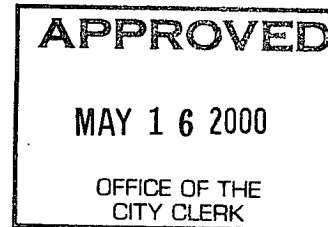

**SUBJECT:** AUTHORIZATION TO ACCEPT DONATION TO RENOVATE  
"KINGS FIELD – HOME OF AIRPORT LITTLE LEAGUE"

**LOCATION AND COUNCIL DISTRICT:** Council District 8

**RECOMMENDATION:**

This report recommends Council approve, by resolution:

- The acceptance of funds received in the amount of \$100,000 from Gifts to Share, Inc. on behalf of the Sacramento Kings to initiate renovations at "Kings Field – Home of Airport Little League"
- To amend the 2000-2004 Capital Improvement Program budget for FY 1999-2000 with the establishment of a Capital Improvement Project (CIP) for the renovation of "Kings Field – Home of Airport Little League" in Council District 8 at Airport Little League

**SUMMARY:**

Gifts to Share, Inc. received a donation in January 2000, from the Sacramento Kings of the National Basketball League in the amount of \$100,000 for the purpose of renovating the field. This report recommends that Council accept the donation.

**COMMITTEE/COMMISSION ACTION:**

None.

**BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

This donation was received from the Maloof family. It was raised during the inaugural "George J. Maloof Senior Community Cup." Gifts to Share, Inc. accepted the contribution on behalf of the City of Sacramento. In recognition of this substantial contribution of \$100,000, the City of Sacramento will recognize the field as "Kings Field – Home of Airport Little League." It is appropriate to establish a CIP to expend the funds on this renovation project. Once established, Gifts to share, Inc. will transfer immediately the \$100,000 donation into the CIP.

**FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS:**

The recommended action is acceptance of a donation of funds for a specific purpose. The associated appropriation authority is created to expend these funds.

**ENVIRONMENTAL CONSIDERATIONS:**

The project has been reviewed by the Planning Division and determined to be exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) under section 15301. The project involves the repair and maintenance of an existing public facility with little or no expansion of use beyond that already existing.

**POLICY CONSIDERATIONS:**

None.


**ESBD EFFORTS:**

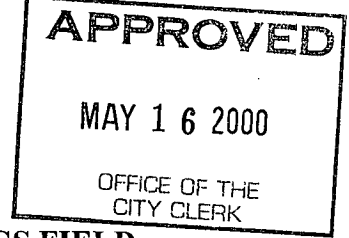
