

RESOLUTION NO. 2007-624

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

August 28, 2007

APPROVING THE PURCHASE ONE ROADWAY STRIPER

BACKGROUND

- A. The Department of Transportation, Street Services Division, Traffic Signs and Marking section, has a need for one roadway striper. The current striper was purchased, used, and is currently non-operational. It is not repairable at a reasonable cost due to the age of the equipment (twenty-two years).
- B. In May, 2007, the City issued a formal Invitation to Bid (B0711811008) for one roadway striper. Three bidders responded. The lowest responsible and responsive bidder was Western Truck Parts and Equipment with a bid of \$209,261.
- C. On June 26, 2007, Resolution 2007-455 was adopted for the purchase of one roadway striper in the incorrect amount of \$207,319.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Award a contract to Western Truck Parts and Equipment, the lowest responsible and responsive bidder, for the purchase of one Roadway Striper in an amount not to exceed \$209,261.
- Section 2. Resolution 2007-455 is repealed due to a typographical error in the amount of the contract to be awarded.


