CONFIRM APPOINTMENT OF CITY COUNCILMEMBERS TO SERVE ON COUNCIL STANDING COMMITTEES AND VARIOUS REGIONAL AUTHORITIES, AGENCIES AND COMMITTEES FOR CALENDAR 2010

BACKGROUND

 & Public Employees Committee and that Councilmember Tretheway shall act as
 chair.
