**SUBJECT: GRANTING REVOCABLE ENCROACHMENT PERMIT FOR 900 8TH STREET**

**LOCATION/COUNCIL DISTRICT:**

900 8th Street  
Council District 1

**RECOMMENDATION:**

This report recommends that the City Council approve a revocable encroachment permit to the applicant, County of Sacramento, for the purpose of constructing two (2) - 4" conduits for fiber optic communication cable between the Sacramento County Sheriff Department and the City of Sacramento Police Department.

**SUMMARY:**

County of Sacramento has requested a revocable encroachment for the purpose of constructing two (2) - 4" conduits for fiber optic communication cable between the Sacramento County Sheriff Department and the City of Sacramento Police Department.

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July 30, 1997

The Department of Public Works has coordinated the review of the application and finds that it meets all City requirements. The permit may be revoked and canceled if the terms and conditions of the permit are not met.

**COMMITTEE/COMMISSION ACTION:**

None.

**BACKGROUND:**

County of Sacramento has requested a revocable encroachment for the purpose of constructing two (2) - 4" conduits for fiber optic communication cable between the Sacramento County Sheriff Department and the City of Sacramento Police Department. See Exhibit "A".

Sacramento City Code, Section 12.04.110, states that Council may, by resolution, grant permits revocable at its will for minor or temporary purposes or privileges on public property subject to such terms and conditions as it deems necessary for the public interest. The use of the property by the permittee shall constitute his acceptance and agreement to be bound by the terms and conditions of the permit.

**FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS:**

The standard permit fee of \$200.00 has been paid by the applicant. The project does not involve any cost to the City. The project is privately financed by County of Sacramento.

**ENVIRONMENTAL CONSIDERATIONS:**

The Planning Services Division, Environmental Section, has reviewed the project and has determined that this project is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) under Section 15305 of the CEQA Guidelines.

**POLICY CONSIDERATIONS:**


The pavement in the project area is at least seven years old, and does not require special pavement restoration due to the proposed "street-cut". This project will require a lane closure permit to be issued by Traffic Engineering Services. The permit shall include provisions for minimal impact on traffic circulation during construction operations.

None, since no goods or services are being procured with this action.





**RESOLUTION GRANTING REVOCABLE ENCROACHMENT PERMIT  
FOR 900 8TH STREET**

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:**

That a Revocable Encroachment Permit be granted to County of Sacramento, 3208 Ramos Circle, Sacramento, CA 95827.

This encroachment is described as follows:

A strip of land 5.00 feet in width, lying within a portion of "I" and "8th" Streets of the Old City Tract, Sacramento County Records, California. The center line of said 5.00 foot strip is described as follows:

BEGINNING at the intersection of the center lines of "I" and "8th" Streets; thence North 71°20'20" West 11.00 feet to the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING of the following two courses: thence (1), from said TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING North 18°39'40" East 115.00 feet to the POINT OF TERMINATION being the south wall of the existing Sacramento County manhole; and (2), from said TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING South 18°39'40' West 4.00 feet to the beginning of a curve to the Southwest having a radius of 10.00 feet through a central angle of 90°, a distance of 15.70 feet; thence North 71°20'20" West 172.00 feet to the beginning of a curve to the Southwest having a radius of 6.00 feet through a central angle of 90°, a distance of 9.5 feet; thence South 18°39'40" West 20.80 feet to the POINT OF TERMINATION.

This permit is granted subject to the "General Provisions - Revocable Encroachment Permit," which were adopted by the City Council in Resolution No. 81-845 dated November 17, 1981. This permit shall be effective only after the applicant files with the Risk Management Division of the City of Sacramento, the insurance certificates required by the General Provisions.

**SPECIAL CONDITIONS**

1. Before digging, notify Underground Service Alert (USA) call toll free 1-800-642-2444.
2. To avoid conflicts determine location of existing underground utilities, conduits, cables, water and sewer mains, drainage mains, gas and petroleum pipes, sewer services, and water services.
3. Show all existing facilities on construction plans.
4. The proposed conduit is to remain a minimum of five feet (5'), measure horizontally, from the outside edge of existing combined sewer system mains and/or maintenance holes.
5. A minimum of one (1) foot separation between the conduit and gutter drain leads is required. If the DI is not a Type "B" or modified Type "B", the conduit shall be placed at a depth to allow future replacement of the DI and lead over the conduit.
6. The proposed conduit is to pass a minimum of one (1) foot below the combination sewer main unless the main is more than 3 feet deep.
7. Future up-grades to the combined system may require relocation of subject facilities. This shall be done at no cost to the City and within a reasonable time frame upon request.
8. Contact Fred McCord 24 hours prior to exposing water main at (916)433-6229. Use caution on crossing the 20" riveted steel water transmission main.
9. A minimum of 6" (six inches) of vertical clearance shall be provided between water mains and proposed conduit (see detail).
10. Water services are normally installed with 12" to 30" of cover in those areas located back of sidewalk.
11. There is a proposed fiber trunk line that the City is installing in "I" Street. It will be located approximately 20' of the south of pavement on "I" Street. Your proposed 2-4" conduits should maintain approximately 5' of clearance from this fiber trunk.
