

RESOLUTION NO. 2009-498

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

July 28, 2009

AUTHORIZING THE APPLICATION FOR AND ACCEPTANCE OF GRANT FUNDS FROM THE CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF FISH AND GAME, OFFICE OF SPILL PREVENTION AND RESPONSE FOR OIL SPILL RESPONSE EQUIPMENT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$25,000.

BACKGROUND

- A. The City of Sacramento responds to petroleum and other spills on both the American and Sacramento Rivers. Currently, our emergency responders need to borrow or lease booms to contain spills and to protect our drinking water intakes and other local resources. The Risk Management Division planned to purchase oil spill containment equipment to save money and shorten response times.
- B. Accepting and executing the grant agreement provides an opportunity for the City to improve its spill mitigation procedures.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The City Manager or the City Manager's designee is authorized to execute all grant documents, including but not limited to, applications, agreements, amendments and requests for payment, necessary to secure grant funds for a grant up to \$25,000 from the California Department of Fish and Game, Office of Spill Prevention and Response.
- Section 2. The establishment of a grant project and related expense and revenue budgets are approved, upon receipt of the grant in order to accept the grant funds.


