 - FEE INCREASES FOR CERTAIN ESTABLISHED ANIMAL CARE & CONTROL PROGRAMS.
 - ON-STREET PARKING VEHICLE IMMOBILIZATION FEE INCREASE

RECOMMENDATION:

This report recommends that the City Council adopt the attached resolutions to:

- Increase the fees for animal adoptions, redemptions, and boarding fees;
- Establish fees for the pick-up of owner's dead animals, and for providing euthanasia services to owner's animals brought to Animal Care & Control;
- Establish a dog license canvassing program;
- Increase the vehicle immobilization fee.

It is also recommended that the City Council approve the concept of the following new programs:

- A cat licensing program, and
- Establishing of an administrative penalty fee process for individuals who continually fail to comply and violate city codes relating to animal control
