Aviation Fuel Agreement

BACKGROUND

- A. The Sacramento Police Department’s Air Operations Unit requires fuel to operate its aviation fleet of three helicopters and one fixed-wing airplane. Since aviation fuel is not available at any City-owned/operated fueling stations, the SPD must purchase aviation fuel from third-party entities.
- B. SPD has negotiated with McClellan Jet Services to obtain aviation fuel at rates comparable to the Defense Logistics Agency’s standard fuel rates, which are on average \$2.95 less per gallon compared to local, commercial fuel providers.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Competitive bidding is suspended for the purchase of aviation fuel.
- Section 2. The City Manager, or the City Manager’s designee, is authorized to execute an Agreement with McClellan Jet Services for the purchase of aviation fuel for a term of five years for a total not-to-exceed amount of \$750,000 through June 30, 2024.
