# AWARD CONTRACT FOR THE SOUTH LAND PARK STEEL WATER MAIN REPLACEMENT PROJECT, PHASE 2 (PN: ZL26)

#### **BACKGROUND**

- A. The existing water distribution system in the South Land Park area is deteriorated beyond rehabilitation. In order to improve reliability and health and safety, City Council approved the South Land Park Steel Water Main Replacement Project, Phase 2 (ZL26) budget in fiscal year 2005/2006.
- B. Pursuant to Assembly Bill 2572 and City Ordinance 2005-090, requiring the installation of water meters on all service connections by the year 2025, this project constructs 163 residential metered water services.
- C. City staff has prepared a set of plans and specifications to construct 9000 lineal feet of water distribution mains complete with new services, water meters, and fire hydrants.
- D. The project was advertised for bidding and bids were received on March 14<sup>th</sup>, 2007 by eight responsive bidders. Florez Paving, Inc, was the lowest responsible bidder at \$1,293,560.

## BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The contract plans and specifications for the South Land Park Steel Water Main Replacement Project (PN: ZL26) are approved, and the contract is awarded to Florez Paving, Inc., for an amount not to exceed \$1,293,560.
