SUBJECT: Recommendation to Suspend the Bidding Process for the Temporary
Parking Lot Project at 13th & I Streets

SUMMARY

This report explains the timetable required to open the temporary surface parking lot at 13th and I Streets for the holiday shopping season and recommends suspending the City's bid process, accordingly.

BACKGROUND

On October 13, 1982 the City Council authorized a Temporary Parking Lot Project for 13th and I Streets, and adopted a Resolution for funding the project. The purpose of opening this temporary parking lot is to transfer monthly parkers from the 11th and L garage during the holiday shopping season for a very low monthly fee. This will open up more parking spaces for hourly parkers in the east end of the downtown area.

In order for the City to proceed with this project and have the temporary parking lot operating by the day after Thanksgiving (November 26) it will be necessary to do part of the work with City forces and part by contractors with the informal bid process. It will also be necessary for the City to act as the General Contractor.


FINANCIAL DATA

The original cost estimate for this project was \$19,000, which was appropriated on October 26, 1982.
