SUBJECT: Findings of Fact Regarding Objections Voiced at
the Weed Abatement Hearing Held on March 17th,
1981 and Resolution Overruling Objections.

FINDINGS OF FACT AND RESOLUTION OVERRULING OBJECTIONS AND ORDERED PERFORMANCE OF WEED AND RUBBISH ABATEMENT WORK

WHEREAS, the City Council by Resolution No. 81-144, set a public hearing for March 17, 1981, at 7:30 P.M., in the City Council Chambers to hear and consider all objections to the proposed removal of weeds, rubbish, refuse and dirt on various parcels of property situated with the City of Sacramento and more particularly described in said Resolution No. 81-144 and

WHEREAS, the notice of the time and place of said hearing was given in the manner provided by law; and

WHEREAS, persons appeared and/or submitted written protests at said hearing to object to the proposed abatement and the Council ordered that the hearing be closed; and

WHEREAS, the City Council, pursuant to Section 19.204 of the Sacramento City Code, has by Resolution No. 75-616, provided the standards for solicitation and award of contracts for the abatement of nuisance of this type.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

1. That one protest was received:

(A) That the protest of Kenneth A. and Kathleen L. Brachman that their parcel number 013-301-25, located at 3741 6th Avenue, should not be on the Weed Abatement notice list because they are now maintaining their lot in a proper manner be upheld and removed from the Weed Abatement list.

2. That the Fire Marshal of the City of Sacramento is hereby ordered to proceed in the manner provided by the City Code, Resolution No. 75-616, and Sections 39560, et. seq. of the Government Code of the State of California, with the abatement of the public nuisances created by said weeds, rubbish, refuse and dirt.

3. That before the City contractor arrives to perform weed and rubbish abatement work, any property owner may remove the weeds, rubbish, refuse and dirt from his property at his own expense and avoid the costs of having said work performed by the City.
