SUBJECT: Los Rios Community College District Master Agreement for Vocational Training

LOCATION AND COUNCIL DISTRICT: City-wide, All districts

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the City Council adopt the attached resolution that authorizes the Chief of Police to enter into an agreement on behalf of the Sacramento Police Department with Los Rios Community College District for vocational training services.

SUMMARY:

The Sacramento Police Department (SPD) requests approval to enter into an agreement with Los Rios Community College District to provide instruction for law enforcement trainees. The agreement is for a one year period from July 1, 1998 to June 30, 1999, with an option to extend.

BACKGROUND:

The Sacramento Police Department anticipates holding two intensive police academies and one extended academy in the upcoming fiscal year. In addition, the police department Training Unit will offer its in-service training program, Continuous Professional Training to approximately 600 sworn and non-sworn employees and hold two Community Service Officer academies and two Police Dispatcher academies.

The master agreement with the Los Rios Community College School District for instructional services will provide the police department with revenues to help mitigate additional expenses to operate the academies.



Upon the completion of the academic year, attendance hours generated by courses offered under this agreement will be totaled. Payment by the school district will be computed based upon \$2.35 per student instructional hour eligible for State general apportionment.

This partnership will provide for an allotment of 15% of the classes for Los Rios Community College students. In addition, academy students would be able to earn college credits for attending the academy.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS:

It is anticipated that this agreement will generate approximately \$325,000 in revenue for the police department. These revenues will be used to mitigate some of the expenses incurred by running the additional academies.

ENVIRONMENTAL CONSIDERATIONS:

This proposal does not constitute a "project" and is therefore exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act according to CEQA guidelines, Section 15061(b)(1) and 15378(b)(3).


POLICY CONSIDERATIONS:

Entering into a contract with the Los Rios Community College School District will allow the Police Department to expand the number of academies currently being operated and to offset the expenses by the revenue received for student instruction hours. It will also enable students to earn college credits for attending the academy.

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SIGN
A MASTER AGREEMENT WITH
THE LOS RIOS COMMUNITY COLLEGE SCHOOL DISTRICT**

WHEREAS the Sacramento Police Department desires to collaborate with the Los Rios Community College School District in providing instruction for Law Enforcement trainees, in accordance with minimum standards as outlined by "Peace Officer Standards and Training Act", and

WHEREAS the police department anticipates running two intensive academies, one extended academy, two community service officer academies, and two police dispatcher academies in the upcoming fiscal year, and

WHEREAS a master agreement with the Los Rios Community College School District would help to offset the additional expenses incurred by operating the academies;

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Sacramento that:

The Chief of Police or a designated representative is hereby authorized to execute a master agreement on behalf of the Sacramento Police Department, with the Los Rios Community College School District for instruction beginning July 1, 1998 for a period of one year with an option for extension by the Los Rios Community College School District.
