SUBJECT: Approval of Plans and Specifications and Authorization to Advertise for Bids for the Reconstruction of the Basketball and Tennis Courts at McClatchy Park, C.C. 2293

SUMMARY:

Plans and specifications for this project have been prepared and copies have been forwarded to the City Clerk. Approval of the plans and specifications and authorization to advertise for bids is recommended.

BACKGROUND:

It has become necessary to reconstruct the basketball and tennis courts at McClatchy Park because the tree roots from the mature trees in the near vicinity have broken up the surface of those courts. At the same time, the fencing surrounding the tennis courts will be replaced, and the low fencing between the tennis courts and the basketball court will be replaced with the 10-foot chain link to prevent tennis balls from escaping the tennis court area as easily as they have in the past.

FINANCIAL:

The City Council has approved \$50,000 in the Parks and Community Services budget from Community Development Block Grant funds for this project. The total amount available for the project is \$48,000. The estimated construction cost is \$42,000.



RECOMMENDATION:


It is recommended that the plans and specifications be approved, and the City Clerk be authorized to advertise for bids to be received on April 2, 1985.
