

RESOLUTION NO. 226

RESOLUTION CANCELLING CITY TAX ASSESSMENTS
ON CERTAIN REAL PROPERTY HEREINAFTER DE-
SCRIBED.

WHEREAS, it appearing that the various lots of land hereinafter described have been purchased by the VETERANS' WELFARE BOARD, an agency of the State of California, and that the title to said lots of land is in the State of California by reason thereof, and that the City cannot collect the various amount of taxes due from the said lots of land, respectively, by reason of such ownership by the State, and that such tax liens constitute a cloud upon the title to the said lots,

IT IS THEREFORE RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Sacramento:

That the following specified taxes on the following described lots of land, respectively, are hereby cancelled and annulled, and the Auditor is hereby directed to cancel the said taxes upon the tax records of the City of Sacramento, to-wit:




