**RECOMMENDATION:**

It is recommended that the City Council:

- Provide comments to SACOG that the City of Sacramento does not support the funding designations in the Preliminary Draft Metropolitan Transportation Plan for 2025;
- Approve by resolution the list of prioritized major street projects in Attachment 3 for inclusion in the plan; and,
- Request that SACOG provide the City with the list of City projects which will be included in the Final Draft Plan by March 28, 2002.

**SUMMARY:**

SACOG has prepared a Preliminary Draft Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP) for 2025 and is soliciting comments from the City of Sacramento. SACOG has also requested a prioritized list of projects from jurisdictions within the six-county region for inclusion in the plan. The draft MTP designates all state and federal transportation funds for regional transportation projects and priorities established by SACOG. In the past, the City has set its own priorities for the use of its portion of these funds and has allocated them to various program areas to advance its transportation goals and objectives.
