SUMMARY

This report requests adoption of the attached resolution which declares the official results of the June 2, 1998 Primary Municipal Election and Special Municipal Election, as certified by the County Registrar of Voters.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

On Tuesday, June 2, 1998, the City of Sacramento held a Primary Municipal Election for the purposes of electing Councilmembers from Districts 1, 3, 5, and 7, and concurrently held a Special Municipal Election to fill a vacancy in Council District 8.

In addition, the City proposed two measures: Measure H- Impartial and Binding Arbitration for Fire

Department Employee Disputes (a charter amendment), and Measure I-Amendment of in-lieu franchise and property tax fees paid by city-operated utilities with a general tax.

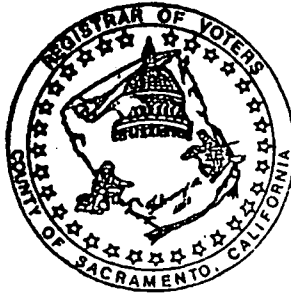

SPECIAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION HELD ON JUNE 2, 1998,
DECLARING THE RESULTS AND SUCH OTHER MATTERS AS
PROVIDED BY LAW**

WHEREAS, a Primary Municipal Election and District 8 Special Municipal Election was held and conducted in the City of Sacramento, California, on Tuesday, June 2, 1998, as required by law; and

WHEREAS, notice of the election was given in time, form and manner as provided by law; that voting precincts were properly established; that election officers were appointed and that in all respects the election was held and conducted and the votes were cast, received and canvassed and the returns made and declared in time, form and manner as required by the provisions of the Elections Code of the State of California; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 98-006 adopted January 6, 1998, the County Election Department canvassed the returns of the election and has certified the results to this City Council, the results are received, attached and made a part hereof as "Exhibit A".

SECTION 4. That the number of votes given at each precinct and the number of votes given in the City to each of the persons above named for the respective offices for which the persons were candidates, are as listed in Exhibit “B” attached.

SECTION 5. The City Clerk shall enter on the records of the City Council of the City, a statement of the result of the election, showing: 1) the whole number of votes cast in the City; 2) the names of the persons voted for; 3) for what office each person voted for; 4) the number of votes given at each precinct to each person; and, 5) the total number of votes given to each person.

SECTION 6. That the City Clerk shall on June 30, 1998, and pursuant to California Elections Code Sections 10265, make and deliver to the person so elected a Certificate of Election signed by the City Clerk and authenticated; that the City Clerk did also administer to the person elected the Oath of Office prescribed in the Constitution of the State of California and shall have them subscribe to it and file it in the office of the City Clerk. The person so elected shall then be inducted into the respective office to which she has been elected.

That the City Clerk shall on November 24, 1998 pursuant to City Charter Section 153, make and deliver to each of the persons so elected a Certificate of Election signed by the City Clerk and authenticated; that the City Clerk shall also administer to each person elected the Oath of Office prescribed in the Constitution of the State of California and shall have them subscribe to it and file it in the office of the City Clerk. Each and all of the persons so elected shall then be inducted into the respective office to which they have been elected.

SECTION 7. That the City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this resolution and enter it into the book of original resolutions.

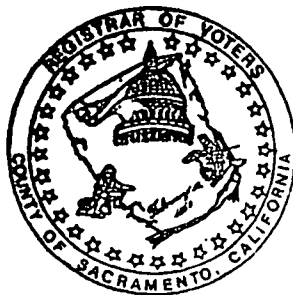

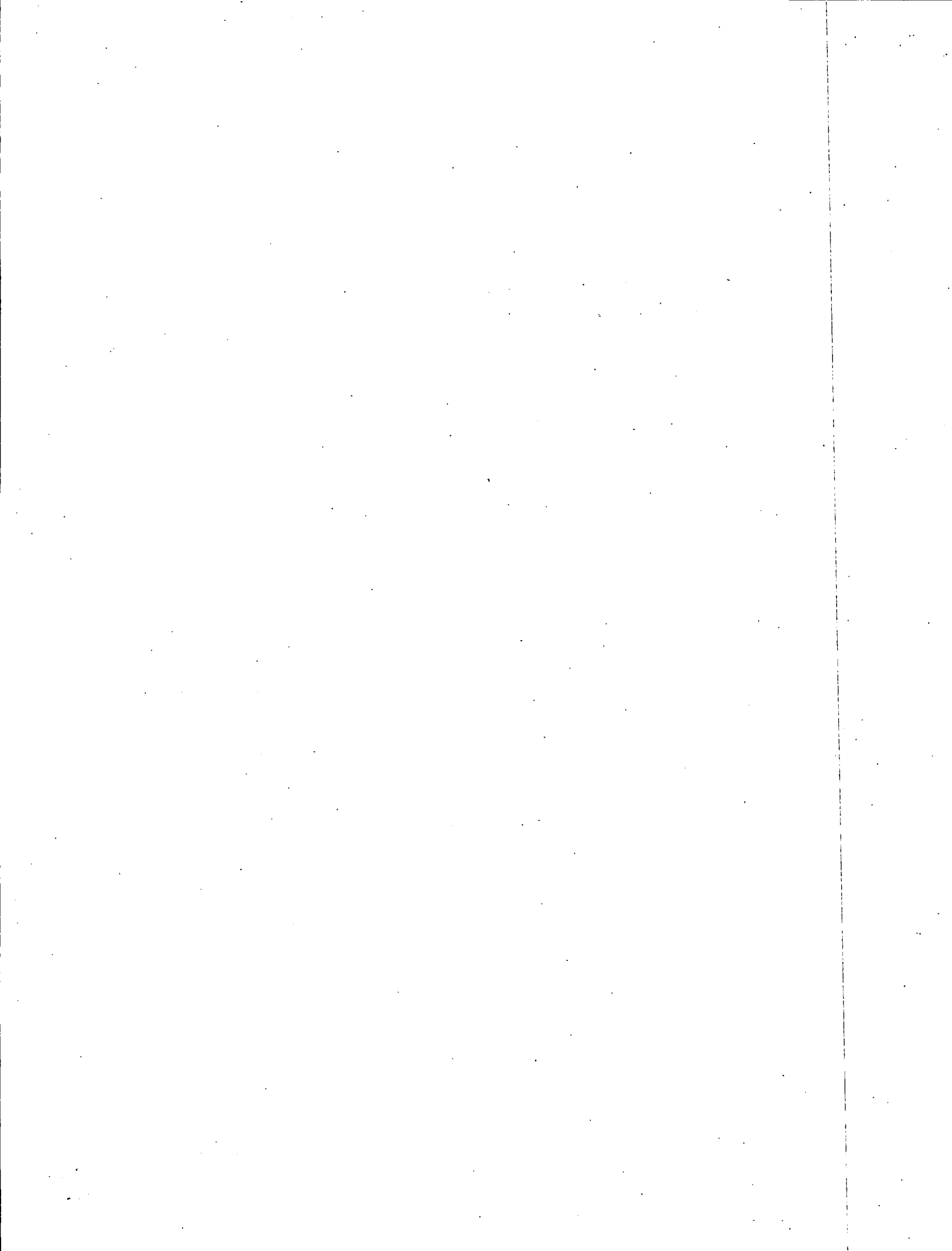
