

RESOLUTION NO. 2008-179

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

March 25, 2008

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITH THE SACRAMENTO HOUSING AND REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY FOR SUPPORT OF RECREATION PROGRAMS AT PHOENIX PARK

BACKGROUND

- A. The City of Sacramento and the Sacramento Housing and Redevelopment Agency (SHRA) have worked in partnership for many years to operate after school and summer recreation programs at the Phoenix Park Resident activity Center that promote educational and enrichment opportunities for youth.
- B. SHRA received a grant from the California Department of Education for after school programs under the 21st Century Community Learning Centers Program.
- C. SHRA desires to have the City of Sacramento facilitate the program at the Phoenix Park Resident Activity Center by providing staff and procuring supplies and services necessary to operate the program.
- D. The amount eligible for reimbursement from SHRA through June 30, 2011 is \$450,000 and should offset the City support to the program.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The City Manager is authorized to execute a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with the Sacramento Housing and Redevelopment Agency (SHRA) by which the City will provide staffing for recreational programs at Phoenix Park in return for reimbursement in an amount not to exceed \$450,000.
- Section 2. The City Manager is authorized to adjust related revenue and expenditure budgets for the reimbursed funds.
- Section 3. The City Manager is authorized to execute amendments to the MOU for a cumulative total amount not to exceed 10% of the original approved amount of the MOU or \$45,000, whichever is less.


