**AMENDMENT TO THE 2003 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT
BLOCK GRANT ACTION PLAN FOR THE
MARSHALL SCHOOL LIGHTING PROJECT**

WHEREAS, the 2003 CDBG Action Plan included the Marshall School Lighting Project, which specified certain locations for street lights to be installed in the Marshall School neighborhood; and

WHEREAS, after community meetings, the desired locations for the street lights has changed; and


WHEREAS, the City desires to amend the 2003 CDBG Action Plan to modify the Marshall School Lighting Project description.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

Section 1. The environmental determination as stated in the staff report that accompanies this resolution is hereby approved.

Section 2. The 2003 CDBG Action Plan is hereby amended to change the project description for the Marshall School Neighborhood Lighting Project as follows:

Both sides of I Street between 28th and 29th Streets, both sides of 28th Street G and H Streets, both sides of H Street between 27th and 29th Streets, the south side of I Street between 26th and 27th Streets, and the east of 27th Street between H and I Streets.
