

## **RESOLUTION NO. 2019-0264**

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

### **Approving Contract Award and Fund Transfer for the Blackbird Park Phase 1 Project (L19109200)**

#### **BACKGROUND**

- A. Blackbird Park is a 9.9acre community park located at 3765 Hovnanian Drive (Council District 1).
- B. The Department of Youth, Parks, & Community Enrichment (Department) is seeking approval to construct phase 1 of the Blackbird Park. The project consists development of a playground, open turf area, baseball field, small and large dog park, group picnic area, community garden, parking lot, concrete walkways, site furnishings and landscaping.
- C. The construction of the Blackbird Park Phase 1 Project is expected to be completed in December 2019.
- D. Additional funding is necessary to cover the construction and staff costs for the project.

#### **BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

- Section 1. Rejecting all bids received on April 10, 2019 for Blackbird Park Phase 1 project.
- Section 2. The construction plans and specifications for the Blackbird Park Phase 1 Project Rebid (L19109200) are approved.
- Section 3. The award of the contract for the Blackbird Park Phase 1 Project Rebid with Robert A. Bothman, Inc. in the amount of \$3,646,300 is approved.
- Section 4. The City Manager or the City Manager's designee is authorized to execute the contract.

- Section 5. The City Manager or the City Manager's designee authorizes the following fund transfers:
- a. Appropriation of \$1,000,000 from the Park Development Impact Fees (Fund 3204) available fund balance to the Blackbird Park Phase 1 Project(L19109200).
  - b. Transfer of \$400,000 from the Westlake Park Ballfield Renovation (L19175200) Park Development Impact Fees (Fund 3204) to the Blackbird Park Phase 1 Project (L19109200).

Section 6. The City Manager or the City Manager's designee is authorized to defund Westlake Ballfield Renovation Project (L19175200) is approved.

Section 7. Authorizing removal of four trees from the Blackbird Park site is approved.
