**A RESOLUTION REPEALING RESOLUTION 91-206 AND  
ADOPTING 1992 CONFLICT OF INTEREST CODES  
RELATING TO BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS**

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Sacramento that Resolution 91-206 is hereby repealed and the following codes are amended to read as follows:

SECTION 1. The Conflict of Interest Code set forth in Exhibit A and B attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference is approved and adopted for the following city boards and commissions:

Board of Plumbing Examiners

SECTION 2. It is the intention of the City Council by resolution to revise the provision relating to conflict of interest codes for City boards and commissions to reflect current law and current City Boards and Commissions. As amended, this Conflict of Interest Code shall apply to calendar year 1992 for all purposes.

SECTION 3. The City Planning Commission shall continue to file their Statements of Economic Interest in accordance with the provisions set forth in Government Code Section 87100-87500 of the Political Reform Act of 1974, as amended.

SECTION 4. All other board and commission members listed in Exhibit A shall continue to file their annual statements during the normal annual filing period.

SECTION 5. It is the intention of the City Council that because the City Council, which is the governing board of the Sacramento City Financing Authority, is required to, and does file, its form 721, which form requires disclosure in all of the required categories, that said form will suffice for purposes of the Authority. The City Clerk shall place a copy of said form in the Clerk's records for the Authority.

SECTION 6. The City Treasurer, serving as the Treasurer of the Authority, shall file with the City Clerk a copy of form 721 for City employment, which form shall suffice for purposes of the Authority. The Director of Finance, serving as the Controller of the Authority, shall file with the City Clerk a copy of form 730 for City employment, which form shall suffice for purposes of the Authority. The City Attorney, serving as counsel for the Authority, shall file with the City Clerk a copy of form 721 for City employment, which form shall suffice for purposes of the Authority. The City Clerk, serving as Clerk/Secretary for the Authority, shall file with the Clerk's records for the Authority, a copy of form 730 for City employment which form shall suffice for purposes of the Authority. The City Clerk shall file aforementioned said copies with the Clerk's records for the Authority.
