

# RESOLUTION No. 263

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of

WHEREAS, the City of Sacramento owns and maintains a municipal water system, and


WHEREAS, in the operation of such system, such municipality has developed an excess of water over and above the amount thereof which is necessary for the use of such municipality and its inhabitants, and

WHEREAS, certain individuals and public districts desire to purchase water from said City of Sacramento,

NOW, THEREFORE, under and by virtue of an Act of the Legislature of the State of California (Stats. 1911, p. 1394) permitting a municipality to sell an excess of water, the City Manager, through the Division of Water of said City, is hereby authorized to sell to such individuals desiring water a portion of said excess of water, as provided in Ordinance No. 555, Fourth Series, of the City of Sacramento.
