## The Crest Theatre 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary

**W**HEREAS, the Crest Theatre will celebrate its fiftieth anniversary on October 20, 1999; and

**W**HEREAS, the Crest was built in 1911 as a vaudeville house and renovated in 1949 as Sacramento's Premiere Movie Theatre; and

**W**HEREAS, the Crest has gone through good times and bad times, neglect and renovation, but is currently at its peak as a crucial part of the city's revitalization of K Street and of downtown in general; and

**W**HEREAS, the Crest houses Sacramento's largest movie auditorium featuring two miles of neon and is the only locally operated theater in Sacramento; and

**W**HEREAS, in 1995 the Crest was completely restored and in 1997 two modern movie auditoriums were added bringing movies seven days a week to the center of K Street; and

**W**HEREAS, the theatre hosts 150 special events per year including concerts, comedy shows, children's theatre and community events and draws 225,000 per year to the downtown.

**N**OW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Council of the City of Sacramento, that we do hereby congratulate the Crest Theatre on the occasion of its 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary and do hereby wish them continued success.
