

RESOLUTION No. 190

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of

June 20th, 1929

WHEREAS, the City of Sacramento has used the following described lot for two years for street purposes, although not the owner thereof; and

WHEREAS, it now becomes necessary to buy said lot for highway purposes; and

WHEREAS, Raymond Greer and James Harrigan, who own said lots, have agreed to sell same for the price of (\$1350.00) Thirteen hundred fifty and 00/100 Dollars, which is a fair and equitable price,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

That said lot be and the same is hereby purchased from said owners at and for the price of \$1350.00; that the City Auditor is hereby authorized and directed to draw a warrant in sum of \$1350.00 payable to Raymond Greer and James Harrigan to be delivered upon receipt of deed conveying good and sufficient title.

Said Lot is described as:

"Commencing at a point on North Side of a County Road 30 feet North 2 deg. 15' West from center of Magnolia Avenue of Oak Park at its Eastern end of West line on land sold by M. J. Dillman to John Tyler, June 1892, and running thence North 83 deg 15' East along North side of County Road 5.41 chs; thence North 1 deg. West 1.845 chs. to a stake; thence South 83 deg. 15' West 5.44 chs. to a stake in fence; thence S 2 deg 15' East along fence 1.845 chs to place of beginning containing 1 acre of land."
