RESOLUTION ACCEPTING QUITCLAIM DEED

WHEREAS, JOSEPHINE FIGUERRIA, ELIZABETH ROSE, ADALINE BOCKEY, ALFRED DA ROZA and WILBERT DA ROZA, each an undivided 1/6th interest, and the remaining undivided 1/6th interest, in JOHN JACINTO, as devisee of Margaret Jacinto, Deceased, subject to the administration of the estate of said deceased, Estate No. 18005, Superior Court, Sacramento County; John Jacinto executor; Mento & Read, Attorneys for executor; as to Parcel No. 1

have made, executed and delivered to the City of Sacramento a certain Quitclaim Deed, conveying to the City of Sacramento the following real property in the City of Sacramento, County of Sacramento, State of California, bounded and particularly described as follows:


PARCEL NO. 1: Block designated No. 26, on map of part Sacramento City, lying between 10th & 23rd Streets, A Street and American River, filed in the office of the Recorder of Sacramento County April 24th, 1850, in Book 1 of Maps, Map No. 8, and bounded by Northerly extensions of 20th Street and 21st Street of the City of Sacramento, and North B Street and North C Street, as indicated on said plat.

That the said Quitclaim Deed be, and the same is, hereby accepted; the City Clerk being directed to attach certified copy hereof to the said Quitclaim Deed, and record same in the office of the Sacramento County Recorder.
