

**AMERICANS WITH DISABILITIES ACT (ADA) RIGHT-OF-WAY
IMPLEMENTATION PLAN – APPROVE FY 2004/05 PROSPECTIVE PLAN FOR
PEDESTRIAN RIGHTS-OF-WAY IMPROVEMENTS AND MEMORANDUM OF
UNDERSTANDING WITH SACRAMENTO MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT, REGIONAL
TRANSIT, SBC CALIFORNIA, SUREWEST BROADBAND, AND COMCAST**

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO THAT:

1. The FY 2004/05 Prospective Plan for Pedestrian Rights-of-Way (Exhibit A) is hereby approved.
2. The City Manager is authorized and directed to execute, on behalf of the City, the Memorandum of Understanding with the Sacramento Municipal Utility District, Regional Transit, SBC California, SureWest Broadband and Comcast to establish a six-month test program for the cooperative removal or amelioration of obstacles in pedestrian rights-of-way.
