## RESOLUTION AMENDING THE SACRAMENTO HOUSING AND REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY 1983 BUDGET

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1. The Redevelopment Agency of the City of Sacramento hereby approves the following amendments to the Sacramento Housing and Redevelopment Agency's 1983 Budget concerning the City of Sacramento's Community Development Block Grant program:

A sum of \$63,961.44 from the following programs:

(a)	77/78 Gardenland A/D #5	\$ 1,318.00
(b)	79/80 Residential Site Acquisition Program	8,721.34
(c)	81/82 C/D Planning Staff	33,893.33
(d)	81/82 Relocation Assistance	399.80
(e)	81/82 Code Enforcement	100.86
(f)	81/82 Conservation Program	100.93
(g)	81/82 McClellan PAC	8,327.18
(h)	1982 McClellan PAC	11,100.00

is hereby transferred to 1983 Community Development Block Grant Contingency.

SECTION 2. The Redevelopment Agency of the City of Sacramento hereby amends the 1983 Agency Budget to reflect an increase of \$267,495.00 in unanticipated 1983 Community Development Block Grant entitlement funds to the 1983 Community Development Block Grant Contingency.

SECTION 3. The Redevelopment Agency of the City of Sacramento hereby amends the 1983 Agency Budget to reflect a transfer of \$78,067.57 from 1983 Community Development Block Grant contingency to:

- 1983 Hagginwood Community Center (\$60,000.00)
- 1982 Community Development Block Grant Administration (\$18,067.57).

SECTION 4. The Redevelopment Agency of the City of Sacramento hereby amends the 1983 Agency Budget to reflect an increase of \$1,633,484.05 in 1983 Rehabilitation Loan and Grant funds transferred from:

- (a) 78/79 SNAP (\$72,500.00)
- (b) 79/80 SNAP (\$150,000.00)
- (c) 79/80 Alkali Flat Rehab/Acquisition (\$100,000.00)
- (d) 80/81 HO/HI Program (\$100,000.00)
- (e) 81/82 Alkali Flat Rehab/Acquisition (\$299,391.05)
- (f) 1982 SNAP (\$911,593.00)
