A RESOLUTION APPOINTING A HEARING OFFICER TO HEAR AN APPEAL FROM THE DENIAL OF AN ENTERTAINMENT PERMIT FOR THE RIVERSIDE CLUBHOUSE LOCATED AT 2633 RIVERSIDE BOULEVARD

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO THAT:

WHEREAS, Sacramento City Code section 5.108.260 provides that any person aggrieved by a decision of the city manager denying, modifying or revoking an Entertainment permit may appeal the decision to the city council; and

WHEREAS, Sacramento City Code Section 1.24.050 provides that the City Council may appoint a hearing officer to hear an appeal when the City Council finds that the hearing may involve a lengthy fact finding process; and

WHEREAS, Appeals from denials, modifications or revocations of an Entertainment permit are not included in the categories of appeal set forth in current City Council Resolutions; and

WHEREAS, An examination of the notice of appeal filed by Matt Haines for the denial of an Entertainment permit for the Riverside Clubhouse located at 2633 Riverside Boulevard reveals that the subject of the appeal may involve a lengthy fact finding process more appropriately accommodated by a Code Enforcement Administrative Hearing Officer.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

The City Clerk shall refer the appeal filed by Matt Haines for the denial of an Entertainment permit for the Riverside Clubhouse located at 2633 Riverside Boulevard to an Administrative Hearing Officer for hearing.


