SUBJECT: Facility Joint Use Agreement with the Sacramento City Unified School District

SUMMARY

This report recommends that the City Manager, by resolution, be authorized to execute an agreement between the City and Sacramento City Unified School District for the use of certain school facilities for community recreation purposes during the summer of 1981.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The City and the Sacramento City Unified School District have a long history of cooperation in providing meaningful recreational experiences to citizens of the City and School District. Prior to the passage of Proposition 13, the School District sponsored an extensive summer school program which contained a leisure and recreational component. The curtailment in State support required that the School District eliminate the recreation component in favor of State mandated programs. The Board of Education, with School District staff support, recognizes the need to assist the City in providing a greater recreation experience during the summer months by making more school facilities available for community recreation purposes.

The agreement emphasizes the period of nine weeks for the 1981 summer program (June 15, 1981 to August 14, 1981). Twenty-five to thirty school facilities will be made available to supplement the seventy to eighty City-owned and operated recreational facilities. In addition to facilities, the School District will provide access to activity equipment needed to conduct recreation programs at no cost to the City.


FINANCIAL DATA

The City and the School District can accomplish the proposed level of co-operation through reallocation of existing resources and the collection of activity use fees. The District intends to re-assign facility support personnel as necessary to accommodate the City scheduled activities. The City will re-assign program personnel to school facilities which will result in an increase in recreational opportunity to the community. Activity use fees will cover the full operational cost of supplementary and enrichment recreation programs.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the City Council, by resolution, authorize the City Manager to execute a joint use agreement with the Sacramento City Unified School District for the purpose of improving recreational opportunities during the summer of 1981.


Gentlemen:
