SUBJECT: RESOLUTION ANNEXING BEAR FLAG WAY INTO THE SUTTER HOSPITAL
RESIDENTIAL PERMIT PARKING AREA

LOCATION AND COUNCIL DISTRICT:

Bear Flag Way from 48th Street to J Street. Council District 3.

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the City Council adopt the attached resolution to annex Bear Flag Way from 48th Street to J Street into the Sutter Hospital residential permit parking area.

SUMMARY:

This report recommends annexing Bear Flag Way from 48th Street to J Street into the Sutter Hospital residential permit parking (Exhibit A). Annexing this street will make it easier for residents to park near their homes by removing the all day commuter parkers.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

- The Sutter Hospital residential permit parking area was established in May 1979.
- Parking congestion is increasing on some streets adjacent to the permit parking area and residents are having difficulty parking near their homes.
- Residents along Bear Flag Way have submitted a petition requesting to be annexed into the residential permit parking area.
- All parking will be prohibited from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. except Sundays and Holidays.
- Residents and their guests will be exempt from the parking time limit when the proper permit is displayed.
- A letter was sent to all of the residents which outlined the request and solicited comments.
- There was no opposition to the proposal.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS:

The cost to implement the recommended parking regulation is estimated to be \$500 for the installation of regulatory signs. Funds are available in the Street Division, Traffic Signs and Markings operating budget. There are no new revenues associated with the recommendation.

ENVIRONMENTAL CONSIDERATIONS:

The Neighborhoods, Planning and Development Services Department, Office of Environmental Affairs has reviewed the project and has determined that this project is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) under Section 15301(c) of the CEQA guidelines.

POLICY CONSIDERATIONS:


This recommendation is consistent with the City Council priority of neighborhood revitalization and enhancement.



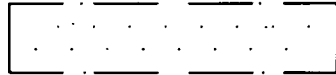

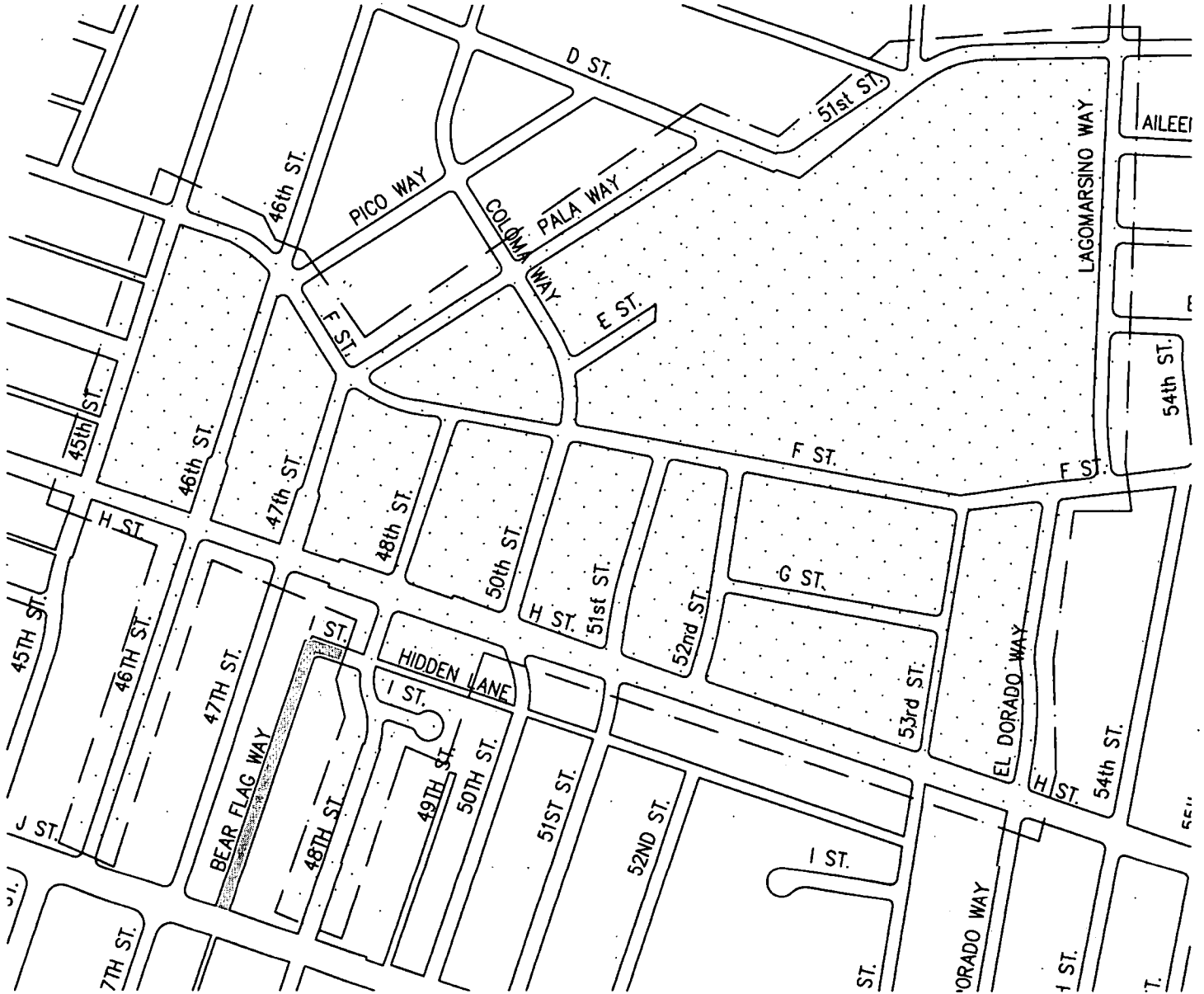




RESIDENTIAL PERMIT PARKING AREAS

**A RESOLUTION ANNEXING CERTAIN STREETS INTO
THE SUTTER HOSPITAL RESIDENTIAL PERMIT PARKING AREA**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 25.10.186 of the Sacramento City Code, whenever the City Council finds that residential streets adjacent to a residential permit parking area have all day, on-street parking congestion, then upon recommendation of the Parking Manager, such residential streets may be added to said residential permit parking area.

THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO THAT:

Parking shall be prohibited from 8am to 6pm except Sundays and Holidays except with "A" permit.

- Bear Flag Way from 48th Street to J Street.
