

RESOLUTION No. 791

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of

June 9 1939

MUNICIPAL NIGHT - ROARING CAMP

WHEREAS, Sacramento is now celebrating the anniversary of its founding by Capt. John A. Sutter in the year 1839; and

WHEREAS, appropriate historic, educational and entertaining programs are being staged by various fraternal, patriotic, civic and public groups at Roaring Camp for the duration of the Centennial,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL, that Monday evening, June 19, 1939, be designated as "MUNICIPAL NIGHT", at which time city officials and employees of the City Government will provide various features of entertainment for the evening; and


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that all city employees be invited to attend and participate in the observance of this occasion, seeking the largest possible attendance of their friends and acquaintances; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor of the City of Sacramento be, and he is hereby, appointed Honorary Chairman of "Municipal Night" and authorized to immediately appoint a committee on arrangements, which shall have full power to act.
