SUBJECT: 2005 CITY STREET OVERLAY PROJECT (PN: RM53) – APPROVE PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS, ACCEPT BID AND AWARD CONTRACT

LOCATION AND COUNCIL DISTRICT:

Various streets in Council Districts 1, 2, 3, 5 and 6 (see Attachment A1 – location maps and Attachment A2 – Streets to be Overlaid).

RECOMMENDATION:

This report recommends that City Council adopt the attached resolution:

- Approving plans and specifications for the 2005 City Street Overlay Project (PN: RM53);
- Accepting the low bid of Martin Brothers Construction in the amount of \$903,072;
- Authorizing and directing the City Manager to execute a contract in the amount of \$903,072 with Martin Brothers Construction.

SUMMARY:

This project will overlay various streets in the City as part of our annual preventative maintenance program.

COMMITTEE/COMMISSION ACTION: None.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The overlay program is an annual preventative maintenance project. Investing in overlays prevents more costly road reconstructions in the future.

This project was advertised and bids were received on May 4, 2005 and are summarized below:

Contractor	Bid Amount (Base Alternate)	ESBD Participation (20% Goal)
Martin Brothers Construction	\$903,072	89.2%
Martin General Engineering, Inc.	\$963,658	83.3%
DeSilva Gates Construction LP	\$1,058,115	25.4%
Granite Construction Company	\$1,076,909	19.9%

The engineer's estimated construction cost was \$909,587.

It is recommended to award to Martin Brothers Construction for its lowest responsive and responsible bid.

Construction is expected to begin in June 2005 and be completed in October 2005.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS:

As of May 16, 2005, the 2005 City Street Overlay Project (PN: RM53) has an unobligated balance of \$1,779,990, which is sufficient to execute the contract in the amount of \$903,072 with Martin Brothers Construction.

ENVIRONMENTAL CONSIDERATIONS:

The Environmental Services Manager has reviewed the proposed action and determined that the project is exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) under Class 1, Section 15301(c) of the CEQA Guidelines. Class 1, Section 15301(c) consists of the replacement, repair or minor alteration of existing streets and highways, including road grading for the purpose of public safety.

POLICY CONSIDERATIONS:

The action requested herein is consistent with Sacramento City Code, Title 3. This project is consistent with the City's Strategic Plan to improve the transportation system and enhance and preserve the neighborhoods.

EMERGING AND SMALL BUSINESS ENTERPRISE (E/SBE) CONSIDERATIONS:

The E/SBE goal is 20%. To encourage small and emerging business participation, plans and specifications were sent to 16 plan rooms and construction service organizations for publication. All are directly involved with E/SBE construction firms. The project was also announced on the City's Internet site at www.cityofsacramento.org/bids. Martin Brothers Construction has 89.2 E/SBE participation.

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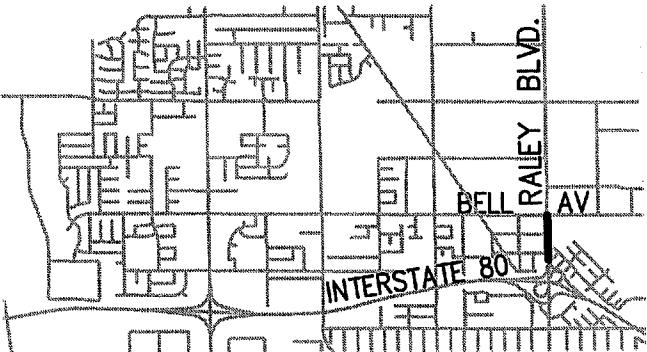

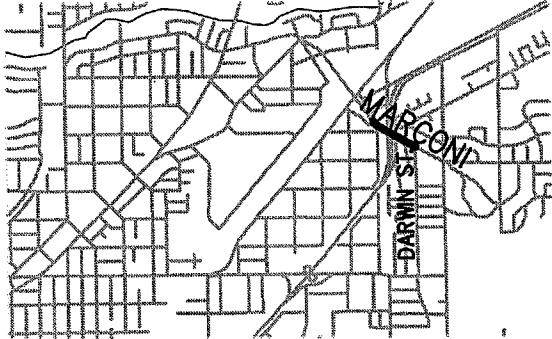
Council District 1



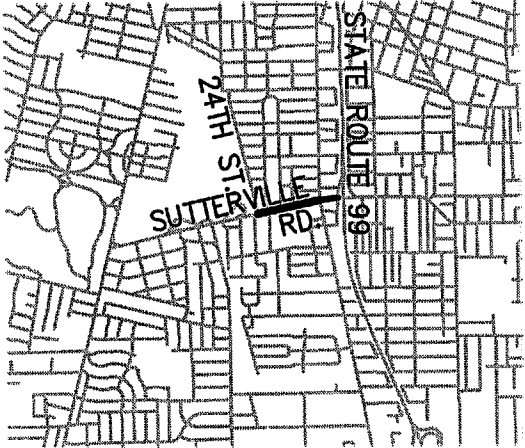

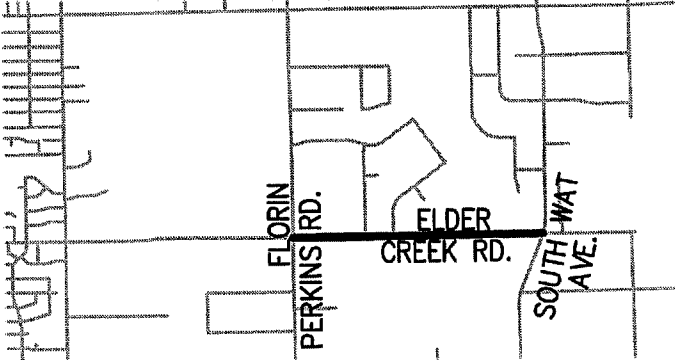
