**SUBJECT: RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A THIRTY MINUTE PARKING TIME ZONE ON  
A PORTION OF BROADWAY**

**LOCATION AND COUNCIL DISTRICT:**

Broadway from 17<sup>th</sup> to 18<sup>th</sup> Streets. Council District 4.

**RECOMMENDATION:**

It is recommended that the City Council adopt the attached resolution to establish a thirty minute parking time zone on Broadway between 17<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup> Streets.

**SUMMARY:**

This report recommends that a thirty minute time zone be established on the south side of Broadway between 17<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup> Streets (Exhibit A). This parking time zone will provide additional customer parking for adjacent businesses.

**BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

- Businesses along Broadway between 17<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup> Streets submitted a petition to establish a thirty minute parking time zone.
- Parking is currently unregulated and is often filled by all day employee parkers.
- Limiting parking to thirty minutes will provide additional short term customer parking.
- There is unrestricted parking for employees within a short walk.
- There was no opposition to this proposal.

**FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS:**

The costs to implement the recommended parking regulations are \$200 for the installation of regulatory signs. Funds are available in the Street Division, Traffic Signs and Markings operating budget. There are no new revenues associated with this recommendation.

**ENVIRONMENTAL CONSIDERATIONS:**

The Neighborhoods, Planning and Development Services Department, Office of Environmental Affairs has reviewed the project and has determined that this project is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) under Section 15301(c) of the CEQA guidelines.

**POLICY CONSIDERATIONS:**

This recommendation is consistent with the City Council priority of neighborhood revitalization and enhancement.

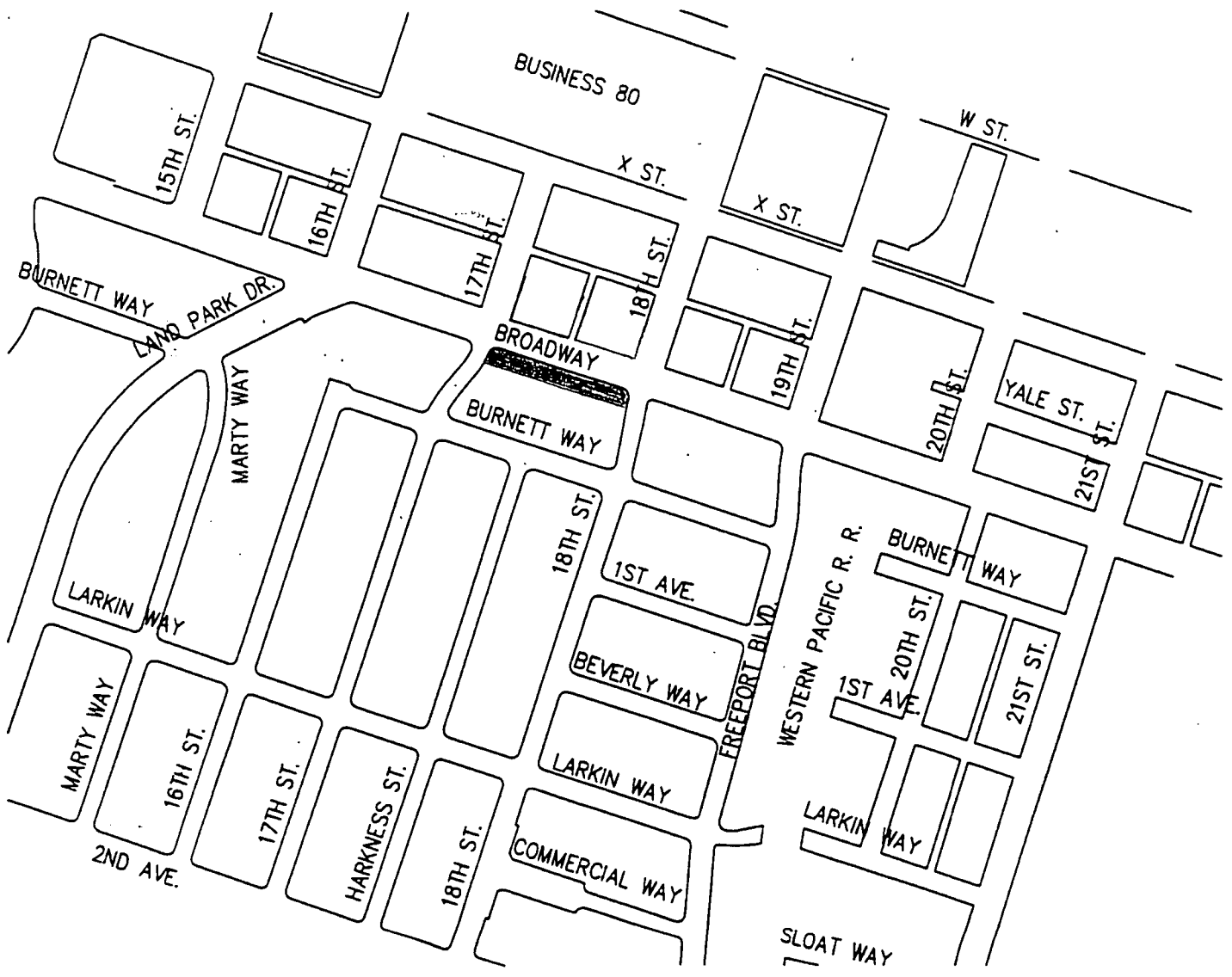

## A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING PARKING TIME LIMITS

**Whereas**, pursuant to Section 25.07.109 of the Sacramento City Code, when authorized signs have been placed by the Parking Manager giving notice thereof, no person shall stop, stand or park any vehicle in a business district or on streets designated by resolution during the days and hours indicated on such signs for a period of time longer than specified on such signs.

**THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO THAT:**

On-street stopping, standing, or parking shall be limited to thirty minutes on the following street:

Broadway, south side, from 17<sup>th</sup> Street to 18<sup>th</sup> Street.
