

RESOLUTION NO. 2007-213

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

April 10, 2007

DEVELOPMENT OF NINOS PARKWAY BIKE TRAIL

BACKGROUND:

- A. On August 24, 2004, the City Council approved the application for grant funds for the development of the Ninos Parkway Bike Trail between San Juan Road and Edmonton Drive.
- B. The proposed project consists of paving and striping of approximately 1,000 feet of Class I bike trail on City-owned undeveloped land. Additional bike trail components include: landscape features such as natural areas with native plantings, shrubs; benches; fold down bollards; and an irrigation system, and an unpaved access road.
- C. Staff was successful in obtaining a State of California, Department of Parks and Recreation, Recreational Trails Program competitive grant for \$150,000 for the development of Ninos Parkway Bike Trail.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Accepting a Recreational Trails Program grant from the State of California Department of Parks and Recreation in the amount of \$150,000 into CIP Reimbursable Fund 248
- Section 2. Establish a Capital Improvement Project (CIP) LS09 for the development of the Ninos Parkway Bike Trail between San Juan Road and Edmonton Drive.
- Section 3. Appropriate \$150,000 from CIP Reimbursable Fund 248 to CIP LS09.
- Section 4. Authorize the City Manager or designated appointee to execute all necessary agreements when received.
