

RESOLUTION No. 704

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of
November 19, 1948

RESOLUTION DECLARING CERTAIN PROPOSALS NUMBERED C AND D FOR THE AMENDMENT OF THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO SUBMITTED TO THE ELECTORS WITHIN THIS CITY AT A SPECIAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION CONSOLIDATED WITH THE GENERAL STATE ELECTION FOR NOVEMBER 2, 1948, CARRIED AS THE RESULT OF THE VOTE CAST AND DIRECTING THE CLERK TO PREPARE A CERTIFICATE THEREOF TO BE SUBMITTED TO THE LEGISLATURE AT ITS NEXT REGULAR SESSION.

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Sacramento did heretofore resolve on the 14th day of September, 1948, to submit certain proposals Numbered C and D for the amendment of the Charter to the qualified electors thereof at a Special Municipal Election consolidated with the State General Election to be held on Tuesday, November 2, 1948; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to said resolution, proceedings were regularly had and taken by the Council for the consolidation of said Special Municipal Election with the State General Election pursuant to the provisions of the Elections Code of the State of California; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable Board of Supervisors did in regular session pass a resolution consolidating the election and directing that said proposals be placed upon the General State Ballot; and

WHEREAS, by the terms of said resolution of the Council, the Board of Supervisors were directed to canvass the vote thereon and report the result thereof to the City Council; and

WHEREAS, subsequent to the resolution of the Council submitting said proposals to the electors thereof, the Clerk did regularly and pursuant to the provisions of law give notice of said election for the time and in the manner required, and all proceedings necessary to properly present said matter to the qualified electors thereof were had and taken; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors, pursuant to law and the authority vested in them, did canvass the vote on said Proposals Numbered C and D on the ballot and a certificate of such canvass has been filed in the office of the City Clerk,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

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That it does declare that said Special Municipal Election consolidated with the General State Election was duly and regularly held on November 2, 1948, pursuant to law and notice given thereof, and that the Board of Supervisors, pursuant to provisions of the Elections Code and the resolution of consolidation, did regularly canvass the vote and report of the result of said proposals as follows:

PROPOSAL NO. C.

Off-Street Vehicular Parking - To amend and add Article XXVI including Sections 273, 274 and 275 to Sacramento City Charter authorizing City of Sacramento to acquire and construct Off-Street Vehicular Parking Places and authorizes Council to issue revenue bonds to pay costs of such.

For said Proposal	<u>35,534</u>	VOTES
Against said Proposal	<u>17,061</u>	VOTES

PROPOSAL NO. D.

Extends Leasing Powers - Proposal No. D Amends Section 15 of the Charter allowing the City to lease up to forty (40) years instead of twenty-five (25) years.

For said Proposal	<u>27,839</u>	VOTES
Against said Proposal	<u>17,705</u>	VOTES

That Proposal No. C for the amendment of the charter providing for the acquisition of Off-Street Vehicular Parking Places and the issuance of revenue bonds therefor, having received a majority of all votes cast for said proposal is hereby declared to have been duly ratified, confirmed and adopted by the People of the City of Sacramento at said election.

That Proposal No. D. providing for the extension of the Leasing Powers of the City from 25 years to 40 years, having received a majority of all votes cast for said proposal is hereby declared to have been duly ratified, confirmed and adopted by the People of the City of Sacramento at said election.

That the City Clerk of the City of Sacramento be, and he is hereby, directed to prepare a certificate of

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the foregoing action of the People of the City of Sacramento on the foregoing amendments to its charter, transmitting the same to the City Attorney who is hereby authorized and directed to have said amendments submitted to and ratified by the legislature of the State of California at its next regular session.
