*CaMKII* is a family of calcium/calmodulin-dependent protein kinases that are ubiquitously expressed and play a central role in learning and memory. *CaMKII* family members are highly diverse and functionally distinct. In particular, *CaMKII* family members are known to regulate each other's activity.

Here we have used a genetic approach to study the functional relationships between *CaMKII* family members. We have characterized the interactions between *CaMKII* family members by examining the effects of *CaMKII* gene deletions on the expression and activity of *CaMKII* family members. We found that *CaMKII* family members regulate each other's expression.
