RESOLUTION ACCEPTING Right-of-Way DEED


WHEREAS, Louis D. Carlson and Ada H. Carlson, his wife, and
John Sandburg and Minnie E. Sandburg, his wife

have made, executed and delivered to the City of Sacramento a certain Right-of-Way Deed, conveying to the City of Sacramento the following real property in the City of Sacramento, County of Sacramento, State of California, bounded and particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the northwesterly boundary line of "River Park", a plat of which is filed in the office of the Recorder of Sacramento County in Book 23 of Maps, Map No. 41, from which point of beginning the most westerly corner of Lot 125 as shown on said plat of River Park bears South 38° 28' 30" West 423.00 feet and thence South 51° 31' 30" East 40.00 feet; thence from said point of beginning North 51° 31' 30" West 288.00 feet; thence curving to the left on an arc of 2626.40 feet radius, said arc being subtended by chords bearing North 56° 57' 40" West 497.57 feet and thence North 67° 49' 50" West 497.58 feet; thence curving to the right on an arc of 1020.00 feet radius, said arc being subtended by a chord bearing North 59° 29' 40" West 485.65 feet; thence North 45° 43' 20" West 300.00 feet; and thence North 70° 44' 35" West 513.36 feet.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

That the said Right-of-Way Deed be, and the same is, hereby accepted; the City Clerk being directed to attach certified copy hereof to the said Right-of-Way Deed, and record same in the office of the Sacramento County Recorder.
