RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO TO FILE AN APPLICATION TO THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA THROUGH THE FEDERAL EMERGENCY ADMINISTRATION OF PUBLIC WORKS FOR A GRANT TO AID IN FINANCING THE CONSTRUCTION OF AN ADDITION TO THE CROCKER ART GALLERY AND DESIGNATING THE CITY MANAGER TO FURNISH SUCH INFORMATION AS THE GOVERNMENT MAY REQUEST.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

That the City Manager be, and he is hereby, authorized to execute and file an application on behalf of the City of Sacramento to the United States of America for a grant to aid in financing the construction of an Addition to the Crocker Art Gallery,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED That said City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to furnish such information as the United States of America, through the Federal Emergency Administration of Public Works, may reasonably request in connection with the application which is hereby authorized to be filed.
