Approval to Donate 1 (One) Boat from the City of Sacramento to the Walnut Grove Fire District

BACKGROUND

- A. The Walnut Grove Fire District is a volunteer department, which is responsible for Walnut Grove and nearby communities and is in need of a boat due to the proximity of the Sacramento River and surrounding waterways.
- B. The Sacramento Fire Department (SFD) will accept ownership of a boat purchased through the State Homeland Security Grant Program from Consumnes Fire Department. This will leave a surplus boat in SFD's fleet.
- C. The Department of Public Works, Fleet Management Division has requested approval to donate surplus Unit 11768, the surplus boat, to the Walnut Grove Fire District.
- D. City Code Chapter 3.80.030 (F) provides that surplus personal property may be donated by resolution of the City Council.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The donation of a surplus boat (Unit 11768) to the Walnut Grove Fire District is hereby approved.
- Section 2. The acceptance of a rigid hull inflatable boat and trailer from the Cosumnes Fire Department is hereby approved.
- Section 3. The City Manager or the City Manager's designee is hereby authorized to enter into the attached hold harmless agreement between the City of Sacramento ("City") and the Walnut Grove Fire District ("Walnut Grove") and any other documentation required to complete the property transfers referenced above.
