Title: Establish a Capital Improvement Project and Appropriation and Transfer of Funds: I Street and J Street Lighting Project (T15115300)

Location/Council District: I Street and J Streets between 20th Street and 27th Streets (District 3). Location maps – Exhibits A of Resolution.

Recommendation: Adopt a **Resolution:** 1) establishing a new Capital Improvement Project for the I Street and J Street Lighting Project (T15115300); 2) appropriating \$406,000 from the Community Development Block Grant (Fund 2007) to the project; and 3) transferring \$47,000 from the Major Street Improvement Project (T15108000) to the project.

Description/Analysis

Issue: Additional street lights are needed to enhance livability and safety for residents on I and J Street corridors from 20th to 27th Streets, and on 20th and 27th Streets from I to J Streets.

Policy Considerations: This project is consistent with the City's goals of promoting safety, livability, and economic vitality.

Environmental Considerations:

California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA): The establishment of a CIP and appropriation and transfer of funds is not subject to the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA). Under CEQA general rule 15061-B-3, CEQA applies only to projects which have the potential for causing a

significant effect on the environment. These actions will have no effect on the environment, this are not subject to CEQA.

Sustainability Considerations: The installation of additional street lights supports walking during evening hours.




Commission/Committee Action: None.

Rationale for Recommendation: Establishing the I Street and J Street Lighting Project (T15115300) and appropriating and transferring funds to this project will enable the City to provide street lighting to enhance livability and safety for residents on the I Street and J Street corridors and 20th Street and 27th Street.

Financial Considerations: This project is funded with \$406,000 in Sacramento Housing and Redevelopment Agency (SHRA) Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds (Fund 2007), and \$47,000 in local transportation funds (Fund 2007). There are no General Funds planned or allocated for this project. The project will be designed for the entire boundary, although funding may not be sufficient for the entire project. The Department of Transportation (DOT) will construct as much of the project as possible within the budget with future construction when additional funding is available.

Emerging Small Business Development (ESBD): None, since no goods or services are being procured with this action.



Background

There are no street lights on J Street between 20th Street and 27th Street, except for mast arm streetlights at the signalized intersections and several SMUD safety lights at non-signalized intersections. There are also no street lights on several blocks of I Street between 20th Street and 27th Street. The Sutter Commons Development Project installed streetlights from 26th Street to 27th Street in 1997. The City's Street Lighting Pilot Program installed streetlights from 21st Street to 24th Street in 1998. The remaining three non-continuous blocks do not have street lighting, except for several SMUD safety lights at the intersection.

The minor collector streets of 20th Street thru 26th Street between I Street and J Street do not have street lighting. 27th Street does have street lighting, which was installed by the City's Marshall Park Street Lighting Project in 2002.

- A. RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

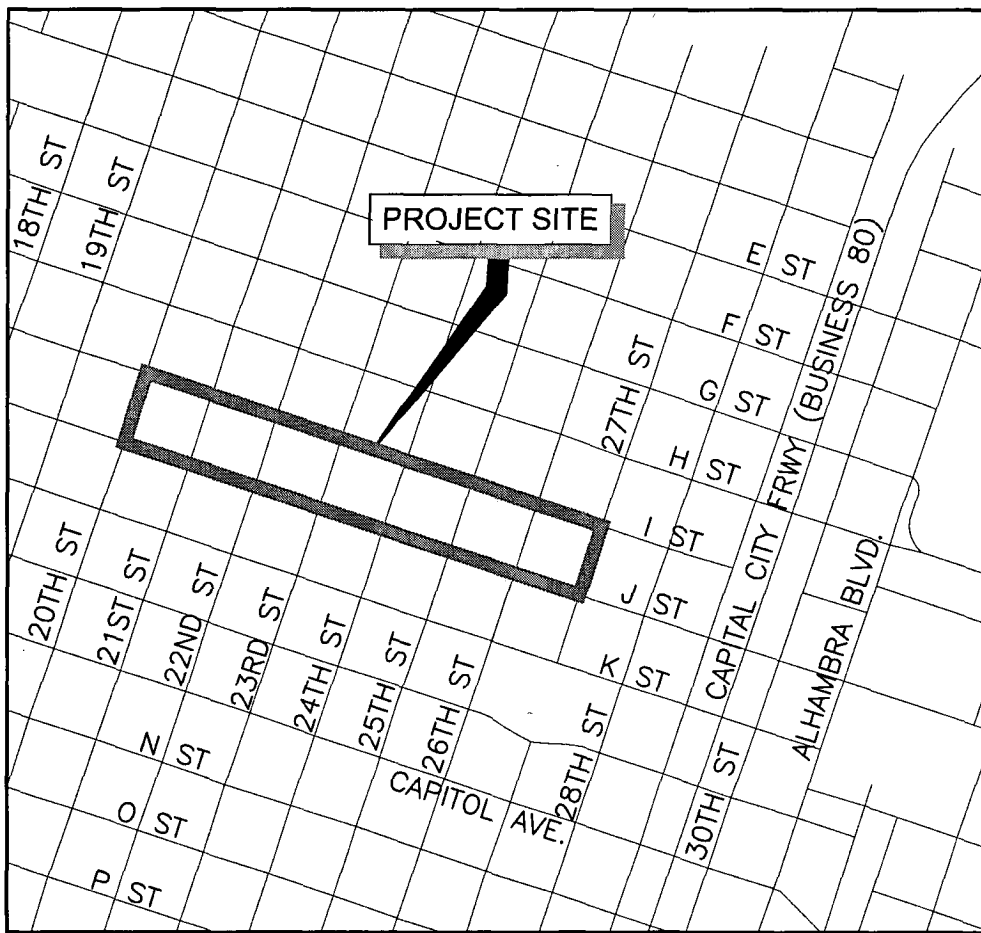
- Section 1. The I Street and J Street Lighting Project (T15115300) is established as a new Capital Improvement Project.
- Section 2. The FY09/10 Capital Improvement Program is amended by appropriating \$406,000 from the Community Development Block Grant (Fund 2007) to the I Street and J Street Lighting Project (T15115300).
- Section 3. The FY09/10 Capital Improvement Program is amended by transferring \$47,000 (Fund 2007) from the Major Street Improvement Project (T15108000) to the I Street and J Street Lighting Project (T15115300).
- Section 4. Exhibit A is incorporated into and made part of this resolution.
