

# RESOLUTION No. 53

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of

WHEREAS, due to the present National Emergency, there is a shortage of grain sacks and it is necessary that unloading facilities be provided whereby the farmers of Sacramento and adjacent territory may handle their grain crop in bulk,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

That Globe Mills be, and it is hereby, granted a revocable permit to construct a wheat unloading pit on Eleventh Street between "B" and "C" Streets, adjacent to the Globe Mills Plant, approximately 50 feet north of the "C" Street property line and covering a space of approximately 25 feet by 20 feet; that said company will promptly and properly make all repairs to the sidewalk or street damaged by the foundation construction.


Said construction, as to location, manner of construction, and maintenance, shall be under the direction of the City Engineer, and according to detailed plans and specifications heretofore approved by the said City Engineer and Building Inspector.

This permit is granted upon the further condition that said company shall protect and save harmless the City of Sacramento from all damage, costs, and causes of action which might arise from this construction.

This permit is granted in pursuance of application heretofore filed by said company.
