RESOLUTION ACCEPTING QUITCLAIM DEED

WHEREAS, GEORGE F. STEINER and GEORGE J. FULLER and RUTH A. FULLER, his wife, have made, executed and delivered to the City of Sacramento a certain Quitclaim Deed, conveying to the City of Sacramento the following real property in the ~~City of Sacramento~~, County of Sacramento, State of California, bounded and particularly described as follows:

Right-of-way over that portion of "Tract No. 1" and "Tract No. 2" on the plat showing partition of the property of the estate of L. R. Davis, which plat was filed for record September 14, 1933, in Book 3 of Surveys, Survey No. 77, described as follows:


Beginning at the northwest corner of the lands now or formerly owned by Nellie P. Walker, which said point is further described as being located North 89° 56' 53" West 2638.29 feet from an iron pin marking the quarter section corner common to Section 25, Township 8 North, Range 4 East, M.D.B. & M., and Section 30, Township 8 North, Range 5 East, M.D.B. & M.; thence from the point of beginning South 89° 56' 53" East 1006.39 feet along the above described line to the northeast corner of the land now or formerly owned by L. R. Davis; thence South 0° 05' West 20.00 feet along the easterly line of the lands now or formerly owned by said L. R. Davis to a point; thence North 89° 56' 53" West 1006.39 feet along a line parallel to and distant 20.00 feet at right angles southerly from the above described line to the westerly line of the land now or formerly owned by said Nellie P. Walker; thence North 0° 05' East 20.00 feet along the westerly line of the lands now or formerly owned by said Nellie P. Walker to the point of beginning and containing 0.46 acre, more or less.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

That the said Quitclaim Deed be, and the same is, hereby accepted; the City Clerk being directed to attach certified copy hereof to the said Quitclaim Deed, and record same in the office of the Sacramento County Recorder.
