SUBJECT: Appeal of Yousef Doumit (Sidewalk Pizza) from the Decision of the Chief of Police denying an Arcade Permit

SUMMARY

Attached is the appeal of Yousef Doumit, Sidewalk Pizza, from the decision of the Chief of Police denying him an Arcade Permit for an establishment located at 3720 "J" Street, as required by Section 5.74, Sacramento City Code.

Under Sections 2.323 and 2.324 of the City Code, the Council may appoint a hearing examiner to hear the appeal if it finds that "the appeal may involve a lengthy factfinding process which would be more appropriately accommodated by a formal hearing before a hearing examiner."

FINANCIAL DATA

The estimated cost would be \$100.00 and would be available from the Chief of Police budget.

RECOMMENDATIONS

1. If the Council should decide to appoint a hearing examiner, it is recommended that the following motion be adopted: "The Council

2. If the Council should decide to consider the appeal itself, it is recommended that the hearing be set for February 16, 1982.



living next to me


