

RESOLUTION NO. 2007-720

CONTRACT AMENDMENT FOR MIDTOWN SACRAMENTO PROPERTY AND BUSINESS IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT (PBID)

BACKGROUND

- A. On August 9, 2007, the City Council conducted a public hearing and subsequently adopted a resolution approving the establishment of the Midtown Property and Business Improvement District (PBID).
- B. The PBID formation process was facilitated by services provided by the Midtown Business Association (MBA).
- C. MBA was initially retained by the City pursuant to Consultant and Professional Services Agreement No. 2006-0773 (Agreement) fixing its compensation at an amount not exceeding \$75,000.
- D. The process of ultimately establishing the PBID went beyond the original scope of the Agreement.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Amendment of the Agreement to reflect additional services provided by MBA and to authorize additional payment in an amount not to exceed \$45,000 is hereby approved.
- Section 2. The City Manager is authorized to execute all documents approved by the City Attorney for purposes of amending the Agreement.
