AWARD CONTRACT FOR THE MULTI-SITE WATER IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT AND APPROPRIATE FUNDS FROM THE MEASURE U PARK IMPROVEMENTS PPROJECT (L19706000) TO THE MULTI-SITE WATER IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT (L19101200)

BACKGROUND

- A. Chuckwagon Park is a 1.87-acre neighborhood park located at 3420 Bridgeford Dr. in Community Planning Area 9, Council District 3. Woodbine Park is a 6.34-acre neighborhood park located at 2430 52nd Avenue in Community Planning Area 4, Council District 5. Valley Hi Park is a 19.77-acre community park located at 8185 Center Parkway in Community Planning Area 4, Council District 7. Robertson Park is a 9.18-acre community park located at 3525 Norwood Avenue in Community Planning Area 8, Council District 2.
- B. The improvements consist of various irrigation system improvements at each park as follows: 1) Chuckwagon Park includes replacement of an irrigation controller, installation of a master valve and flow sensor, a domestic backflow preventer, tubular steel fence enclosure, concrete flatwork, and decomposed granite paving; 2) Woodbine Park includes removal of abandoned booster pump and concrete vault, replacement of an irrigation controller, installation of a master valve and flow sensor, tubular steel fence enclosure, concrete flatwork, decomposed granite paving, automatic irrigation system, and landscape planting; 3) Valley Hi Park includes replacement of a booster pump assembly and concrete boxes for the existing master valve and flow sensor; 4) Robertson Park includes replacement of an irrigation controller.
- C. The formal bidding process for Multi-Site Water Improvements Project was posted in accordance with City Code 3.60 and Administrative Policy AP-4002 on September 14, 2016. No bids were received. Staff solicited bids from three contractors on the plan holders lists.
- D. Construction of the Multi-Site Water Improvements Project is expected to be completed by the end of December 2016.
- E. Appropriating funding from the Measure U Park Improvements Project (L19706000) Fund 2401, in the amount of \$60,000 to the Multi-Site Water Improvements Project (L19101200), will allow staff to complete the necessary improvements.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The Plans and Specifications for the Multi-Site Water Improvements Project (L19101200) are approved.
- Section 2. The construction contract is awarded to Abide Builders, in the amount of no-to-exceed \$345,676 for the Multi-Site Water Improvements Project (L19101200).
- Section 3. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute a construction contract with Abide Builders in the amount not-to-exceed \$345,676 for the Multi-Site Water Improvements Project (L19101200).
- Section 4. The appropriation of funds from the Measure U Park Improvements Project (L19706000) Fund 2401, in the amount of \$60,000 to the Multi-Site Water Improvements Project (L19101200) is approved.
