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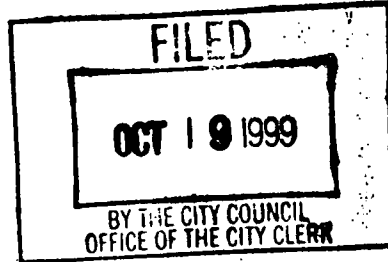

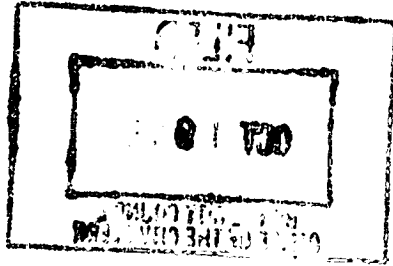
**SUMMARY**

Chapter 749, Statutes of 1996, requires the City Treasurer to make a monthly investment transaction report to the City Council. This Monthly Investment Transaction Report fulfills that requirement for the month ended August 31, 1999.

**COMMITTEE/COMMISSION ACTION:** None

**BACKGROUND**

Chapter 749, Statutes of 1996, was enacted (in addition to Chapter 783, Statutes of 1995) to help avoid a repeat of the December 1994 Orange County investment breakdown that resulted in investment losses for Orange County and other local government entities. This is the investment transaction report required and submitted to Council.



**BACKGROUND – Continued**

Chapter 749 has two main requirements. The first is that the City Council annually delegates authority to the City Treasurer to invest or reinvest City funds and to sell or exchange securities purchased for a period of one year. Since the delegation of authority, the City Treasurer has assumed full responsibility for the transactions until delegation of authority is revoked or the one year period expires. This delegation was made with the quarterly investment report for the period ended June 30, 1999.

The second requirement is for the City Treasurer to submit a monthly report of the transactions to the City Council. The transactions for the month of August 1999 are attached as follows:

- Attachment A: City Investment Pool A
- Attachment B: The Ann Land/Bertha Henschel Public Trust Mutual Fund
- Attachment C: The Ethel MacLeod Hard Fund for Senior Citizens
- Attachment D: Sacramento Housing and Redevelopment Agency

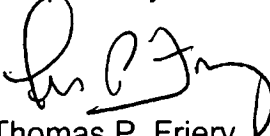
**ENVIRONMENTAL CONSIDERATIONS**

It is respectfully recommended that the City Council approve the proposed agenda for the joint meeting with the cities of West Sacramento and Sacramento City Councils on Tuesday, November 16, 1999.

**BACKGROUND**

On August 17, 1999, the West Sacramento City Council and Sacramento City Council met in joint session. This meeting was held in the city of Sacramento. At that time, both councils agreed to meet for a second time in the city of West Sacramento on November 16, 1999.

At the August 17, 1999 meeting, several topics, spanning many different subject areas, were suggested as potential agenda items for the November 16, 1999 meeting. In order to continue a productive and focused dialogue, staff is recommending that the items for the November 16, 1999 meeting focus on riverfront activities and issues primarily between the "I" Street and Tower Bridges.

**ANALYSIS**

The proposed agenda for the November 17, 1999 meeting includes the following items:

**Oral Reports on:**

- Sacramento Embassy Suites Hotel
- Triple A ballpark facility in West Sacramento
- Presentation on Sacramento waterfront restaurant
- Relinquishment of SR 275

**Action Items:**

- Consideration of scope of work and budget allocation for a joint waterfront marketing plan
- Consideration of recommendations relative to the lighting and painting of the "I" Street Bridge
- Consideration of options for an oversight body for waterfront activities

### **Strategic Plan Integration**

The city of West Sacramento strategy, "Plan for Progress", is exemplified through the actions proposed in this agenda report. Working together with a neighboring city on issues relative to riverfront activities is planning for progress in a positive way by both cities.
