RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING VARIOUS ACTIONS TO EXPAND THE 4TH "R" CHILD CARE PROGRAM TO WITTER RANCH ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

WHEREAS, the City of Sacramento desires to continue, improve and expand its child care programs at elementary schools throughout the City and at County locations,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

1. The City Manager is authorized to accept a \$200,000 interest-free loan from the California Department of Education (CDE) to fund the construction of a new 4th "R" child care facility at Witter Ranch Elementary School and to sign the State Contract and Lease to Own Agreement;
2. A new Capital Improvement Program (CIP) project is established for the construction of a 4th "R" child care facility at Witter Ranch Elementary School (PN: LX81) and \$250,000 is appropriated from the 4th "R" Fund (474);
3. Staffing in the Parks and Recreation Department is augmented by 4.75 FTE to provide staffing for the 4th "R" program at Witter Ranch Elementary School and the operating budget is amended by \$244,209:

Program Coordinator	1.00 FTE
Program Developer	1.00 FTE
Typist Clerk III	1.00 FTE
Recreation Aide	1.75 FTE

4. The City Manager is authorized to execute all agreements and documents, including any extensions or amendments thereto, with the State of California and the Natomas Unified School District related to the development and use of a 4th "R" child care facility at Witter Ranch Elementary School.
