NOTICE OF DECISION
AND
FINDINGS OF FACT

At its regular meeting of March 6, 1984, the City Council heard and considered evidence in the above entitled matter. Based on oral and documentary evidence at said hearing, the Council approved the appeal based on the following findings:

- 1. The Variance will not constitute a special privilege in that the sign has been in existence prior to adoption of the freeway sign regulations.
- 2. The Variance will not be injurious to the public welfare in that the proposed sign will not create a proliferation of signage in the area.
- 3. The granting of the Variance does not constitute a use variance in that the waterbed facility is permitted in the M-2-S zone.
- 4. The Variance is consistent with the General Plan in that the site is designated for Industrial Uses.
