**APPROVING AN AGREEMENT WITH JONES AND STOKES ASSOCIATES  
FOR FY2005/06 WATERSHED GRANT CONSULTATION SERVICES**

**BACKGROUND**

- A. Based on the results of a consultant selection process, City staff has negotiated a consultant services agreement with Jones and Stokes to provide consultant services for the Arcade Creek watershed grant received from the State Water Resources Control Board.
- B. The services include public outreach, developing a watershed management plan, removal of non-native invasive plants, acquiring federal, state, and local permits necessary to complete a wetland filtration system in Del Paso Regional Park, and conduct post-construction monitoring and draft reports related to wetland filtration system and other grant activities.

**BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL  
RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. The City Manager is authorized to sign and execute a consultant services agreement with Jones and Stokes Associates for the 2005/2006 National Pollution Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Project (PN: WM66, fund 512) for an amount not to exceed \$447,581.
