

Attachment 01 – Description/Analysis

Issue: The City of Sacramento has four golf courses that are currently leased to The First Tee of Greater Sacramento (First Tee) and Morton Golf, LLC. The First Tee lease commenced on September 1, 1998 and the Morton Gold lease commenced on January 1, 2012.

First Tee leases the William Land Park Golf Course and offers educational programs at several City golf courses, schools, and community centers. These education programs build character, instill life-enhancing values, and promote healthy choices through the game of golf.

Morton Golf operates the Haggin Oaks Golf Complex, Bing Maloney Golf Complex, and Bartley Cavanaugh Golf Course, as well as the William Land Park Golf Course on behalf of First Tee. The City oversees the lease agreements and partners with both organizations to ensure that maintenance and capital improvements are pursued with shared standards and vision for the future.
